PLACE

This flagship Pinot Noir is a pure representation of the coastal terroir in Monterey County. The name "Submarine Canyon" is a reference to the deep underwater canyon located in the Monterey Bay. This deep sea canyon provides the ideal marine climate for growing premium Pinot Noir grapes. All five of the vineyard sites from where we source fruit experience a strong marine influence. Ancient glacial soils made up of sand, gravel, limestone, and shale loam help create wine with bright acidity, vibrant fruit and medium weight and texture.

WINEMAKING

- The grapes were mostly de-stemmed with 15% remaining whole clusters.
- Fermented with native yeast at cool temperatures in small open-top temperature controlled tanks.
- The wine was aged on its lees for 10 months in neutral French oak barrels.
- Racked to tank and allowed to settle for a month prior to being bottled unfinned and unfiltered.

AROMA *Kirschwasser, strawberry-rhubarb pie, sage blossom, dried roses*

PALATE *Bing cherry, raspberry, pomegranate, cranberry, rosewater*
